Council woman Lori Boyer gave reports on many areas of interest regarding our city:

- Wicked Barley Brewery is still in process of getting approval. Additional requirements of no loud music on deck, 25 foot landscape buffer, and 8 foot stucco wall between business and neighborhood it will back up to.
- Sales at Palazzo at St Johns are lower than company would like. They are considering tearing down the third building.
- A drainage ditch caved in in Barrington Oaks. It is being repaired.
- Council does not want the city to borrow money for operations.
- Council elections are March 24. Lori Boyer is running for a position-if you would like to put a sign in your yard, call her office.
