Make video or film record of all your valuables. Record serial numbers on items that have them.

New Business:

Treasurer report: Paid \$250 to have the yard of Strongman Family at corner of Rathbone and Old Kings S cleaned up. It was an eyesore to a main neighborhood entrance.

We have a bank balance of \$500.18. No major expenses are forseen at this time.

A motion was passed to approve buying plants for sign bases.
