Inspector Hodge of JFRD was introduced. He passed out brochures about fire safety and prevention. He presented a video. About 150,000 calls in 2015; 100,00 of those were medical emergencies. Send someone out to street to flag down rescue personnel. If you need a smoke detector call 630-city for free smoke detector and installation. Change batteries every 6 months, test them monthly. Do fire drills at home. Put life before property—do not go back in to retrieve things. Visit local fire station so kids can see what fire fighters look like in their equipment. He demonstrated how to use a fire extinguisher.

Treasurer's Report: Frack reported we have \$475.37. PO Box rental fee of \$64 for next 6 mos. has just been paid. Donations of \$50 were collected at the Nov. meeting. Our state association fees will be due soon.

Neighborhood Watch reports: New side and original side—we have just requested new sign stickers. We need block captains to pass out flyers about monthly meetings on both sides. Nancy Barry oversees the new side (32257) and sends out emails about safety issues. Lora Lewis oversees the original side (32217). The original side has recently installed 3 Neighborhood Watch signs.
